The mandatory requirements would be the ones used in the job posting, while the preferred requirements become the job description and would be used in the selection/interviewing process.

There was a discussion on considering an applicant from out of state even through we are planning to advertise only in the state of Michigan. It was felt that if the individual met the position requirements we would want to consider that person. We would not, however, pay transportation expenses in order for candidates to come for an interview.

Based on the agreed upon mandatory and preferred criteria, Williams will prepare a draft document for the Commissioners to review and agree to before doing the job posting.

It was agreed that a special meeting would be called for Monday, November 21, 2011, to review, make any necessary revisions, and agree to the position description.
